

## PRESIDENT'S SPECIAL PROJECT

At the heart of it all is FUN, surrounded by Service, Commitment, Loyalty, Caring, and Kindness.

- Using a five-pointed star, the FIRST Point of Light challenge is for 75% of our state's clubs to support the National Day of Service in September.
- The SECOND Point of Light in the challenge is to double our participation in the Legislative Action Center.
- The **THIRD Point of Light** in the challenge is for 75% of our clubs to support one of the **GFWC Affiliate Organizations**.
- The **FOURTH Point of Light** in the challenge is to **Shout Out Your Story** with 75% of our clubs updating and expanding their visual presence in the community.
- The **FIFTH Point of Light** promotes reading and supports literacy, both paramount to developing strong communities and future leaders. Libraries and books open a world of imagination, escape, and sense of power.

The challenge as a state is to raise \$6,000 to be shared equally between three reservation locations - the Boys and Girls Clubs of the Northern Cheynne Nation, the Jocko Valley Library in Arlee on the Flathead Reservation, and the Glacier County Library Memorial Foundation serving the Blackfeet Reservation.
