



Resolution: Protection of Voter Information in Montana

WHEREAS, the right to privacy and the protection of personal information are fundamental to maintaining public trust and the integrity of the electoral process; and

WHEREAS, the current Montana voter portal permits access to a voter's personal information, including registration status and voting method, with only the voter's name and date of birth; and

WHEREAS, this level of access creates significant safety risks for all individuals; and

WHEREAS, ensuring the confidentiality of voter information is essential to protect and uphold the safety and security of all Montana residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that General Federation of Women's Clubs of Montana urges the Montana state government to implement enhanced security measures for the voter registration portal, including, but not limited to, multi-factor authentication, stricter verification requirements, and special protections for the information of individuals;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that General Federation of Women's Clubs of Montana encourages the Montana state government to prioritize the protection of voter information, and to consult with cybersecurity and victim advocacy experts to develop and maintain a secure, user-friendly voter registration system;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be transmitted to the Governor of Montana, the Montana Secretary of State, and other relevant officials, demonstrating the commitment of General Federation of Women's Clubs of Montana to the safety, security, and privacy of all Montana voters.
